Intent – Concepts

Extend To do practice questions under controlled conditions and give peer to peer feedback using the exam criteria.

What subject specific language will be used and developed in this topic?

Historical context, vocal skills, tone, pitch pace, intonation, emphasis, physical expression, proxemics, levels, relationships, stage design, director, lighting, costume. Social class, genre, style.

What opportunities are available for assessing the progress of students?

Students will be assessed termly through written practice questions in lessons. They will also be formally assessed in the year 10 mock examination.
