Intent – Rationale

To build confidence in speaking, writing, reading and listening on the topic of career, part-time jobs and ideal jobs and ambitions. This topic feeds into the French GCSE where pupils write and speak about their part-time jobs, and what they would like to do in the future in detail. The scheme also aims to build cultural awareness on francophone jobs (particularly in France) and make comparisons with their own experiences.
