Intent – Rationale

By studying this topic students will be able to give information to French speakers about their homes and will be able to understand similar information given by a French speaker. They will have a better understanding of describing their local area and region and will be able to discuss their own preferences and experiences. They will be able to use the conditional tense with regular verbs with accuracy.

- To understand the use of demonstrative adjectives (ce, cette, cet, ces)
- To recognise possessive pronouns and understand what they mean (le mien, le tien, le sien etc)
