# <u>French Scheme of Learning</u> <u>Year 11 – Term 1/Theme 2 – Unit 8 Travel & Tourism</u>

### <u>Intent – Rationale</u>

By studying this topic students will be able to give information to French speakers about travel and tourism. They will be able to talk about holidays they like; holidays they have been on; and holidays they would like to go on in the future (or if money was no object)! They will improve their geographical awareness of France. They will use the perfect & imperfect tenses with confidence and will learn how to use more complex structures.

### Intent – Concepts

#### What knowledge will students gain and what skills will they develop as a consequence of this topic?

- To be able to describe our best or worst ever holiday using the perfect and imperfect tenses
- To discuss different activities you could do on a holiday to France
- To describe holidays we used to go on when we were younger
- To describe our holiday plans in detail using a range of tenses (past; present & future)

#### **Extend**

- To introduce more complex structures (e.g. après avoir + pp) into our work
- To use a wider range of tenses based on prior learning (e.g the conditional)
- To describe the holiday preferences of others using 3<sup>rd</sup> person verb forms
