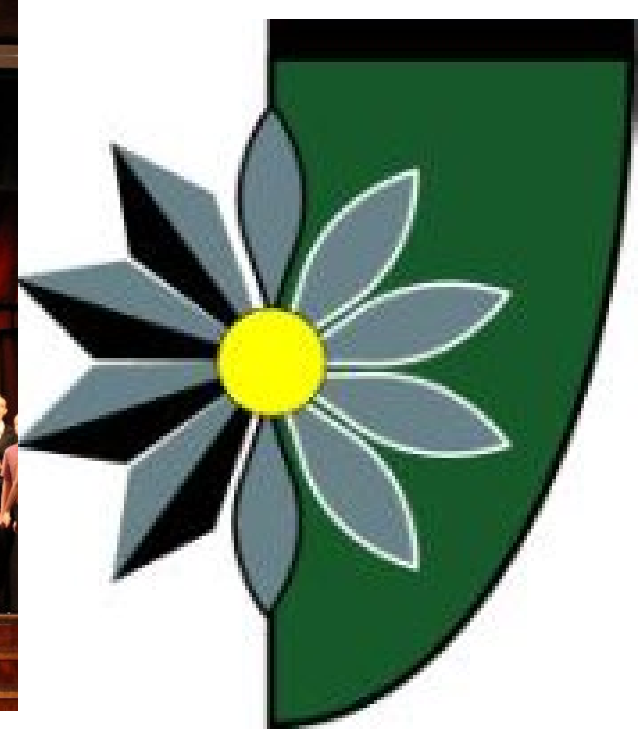

Appropriate Accommodations & Exam Access Arrangements

- All schools must make their own decisions about Exam Access Arrangements (EAAs) and classroom adaptations, based on clear and robust evidence, including previous information, specialist reports, and in-school assessment.
- At secondary level, EAAs must meet the stricter criteria set by the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ).
- Support provided during the 11+ (e.g. extra time, reader, scribe, prompter, or classroom adjustments) does not automatically transfer to secondary school. We must gather evidence to ensure any support is necessary and in line with current regulations.
- Your child's previous way of working, both in exams and in the classroom, will be carefully considered as part of this process.
- Please see Mrs Brown (SENCo) in the hub if you would like to discuss this further.

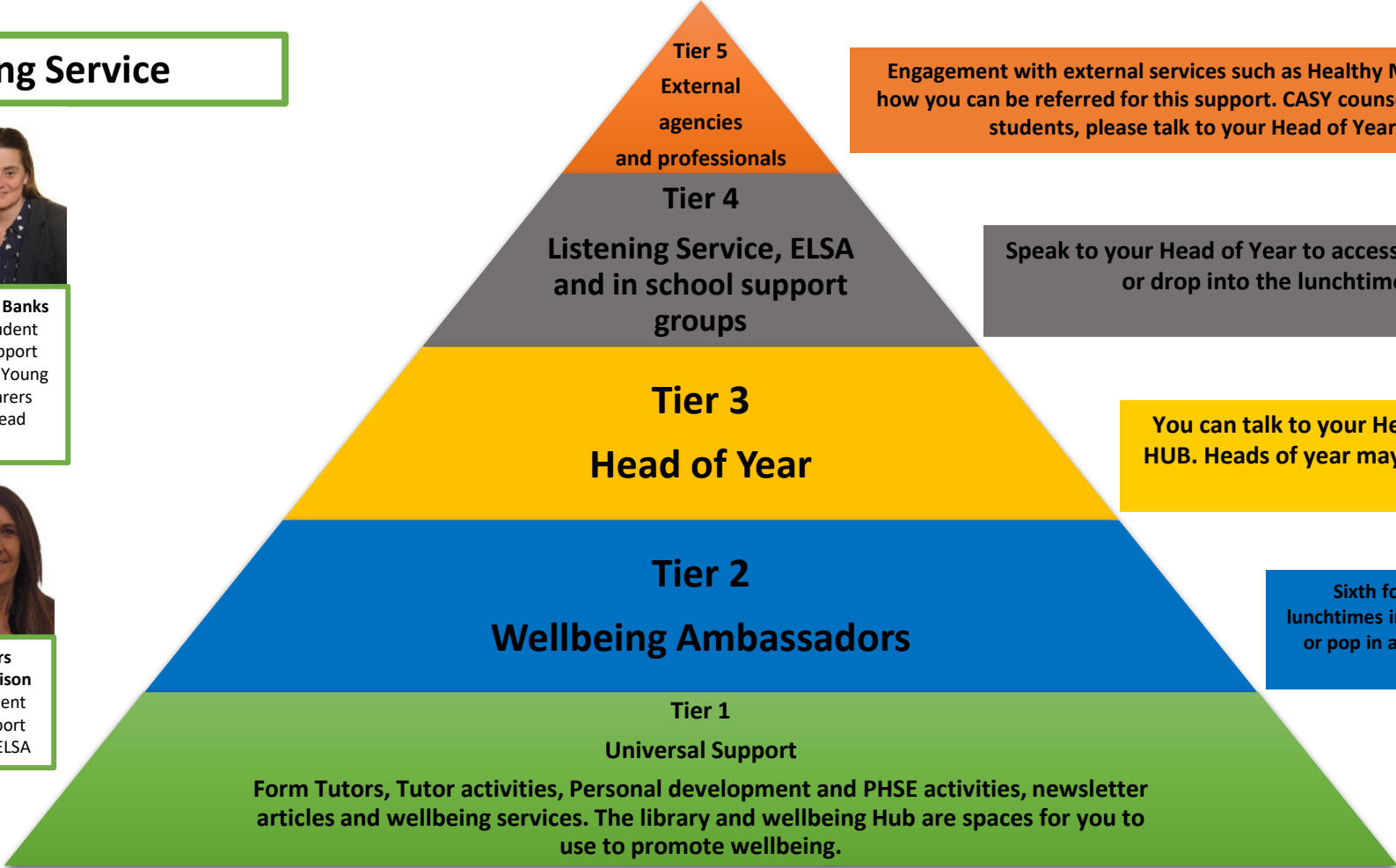

Engagement with external services such as Healthy Minds, MHST and CAMHS. We can talk to you about how you can be referred for this support. CASY counselling is also used within the school to support some students, please talk to your Head of Year, or any member of the Listening service.

Speak to your Head of Year to access support from the Listening service or ELSA. Join or drop into the lunchtime support groups in the pastoral HUB.

You can talk to your Head of Year; Heads of Year can be found in the HUB. Heads of year may be able to signpost you to access appropriate support.

Girls on Board

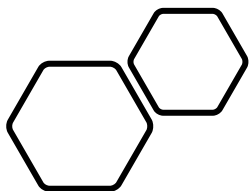
An approach to help schools help girls (aged 7 to 18) navigate the choppy waters of friendship problems.
