

Participation in off-site activities

At Kesteven & Sleaford High School we are pleased to offer a wide range of learning opportunities for your child to help with their education and personal development. This includes a wide programme of educational visits, which take place both in the vicinity of the school and beyond. We also encourage your child to join the school's sports teams.

As many local visits and sporting fixtures will often be arranged at quite short notice, and by their nature will normally be low risk activities, we do not wish to overburden you with undue and impractical requests for your written consent to take your child from the school site.

In order to fulfil our statutory obligation, we would be grateful if you would provide your consent to your child participating in off-site activities and to receiving first aid or emergency medical treatment, by signing the Parent/Carer agreement within the admissions booklet.

This will act as general consent to local visits of a low-risk nature as outlined above. You will of course receive separate notification of visits of a more hazardous nature, which take place further from the school site and which are arranged well in advance.

You may be assured that all our visits, whether local or more distant, will be properly risk assessed to take account of the site, the activity, the staff involved and the needs of your child. Copies of these risk assessments will be available in school for your inspection on request.
