

The School Library - Learning Resource Centre

The library is an important part of daily school life, and a very popular and inclusive space for all our students. Access to a school library helps students to achieve and develop pathways that will lead to greater levels of literacy, social responsibility, empathy, and successful academic achievement.

We have a broad and diverse range of fiction and non-fiction titles to browse and borrow, a suite of computers, careers/higher education section, formal seating for study, and a comfy 'read and relax' corner. Students are provided with individual log-in details that enable them to remotely access their library accounts and explore the library catalogue. In addition, any student wishing to read from an electronic format can download and log in to the school E-Book App which provides access to a further selection of titles.

There is a dedicated collection of resources to support students with their wellbeing and mental health, and the library is a central point within the school for students to spend time exploring and developing themselves as individuals, either through their studying or pastoral interests. There are a range of extra-curricular clubs based in the library and a varied timetable of events throughout the year that aim to promote a lifelong love of reading.

The library is open from 8.30am and remains open after school until 4.30pm (Monday-Thursday) and 4pm (Friday).
